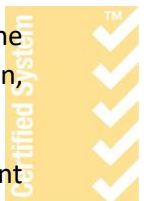

An ASP3 (Accredited Service Provider Level 3) designer in NSW typically handles the design and certification of electrical network connections - mainly contestable works associated with distribution networks. This includes:

- Design new electrical connections - including LV/HV reticulation, load assessments, and point of supply.
- Plan network augmentations - such as transformer upgrades, feeder extensions, and capacity improvements.
- Deliver subdivision and development designs - for greenfield, infill, and multi-lot projects
- Prepare and manage contestable design packages - drawings, BOMs, and DNSP approvals.
- Ensure compliance and technical integrity - earthing, protection, fault levels, and standards.
- Certify and support delivery - as-builts, commissioning support, and coordination with ASP1/ASP2 contractors.
